The winners of the quiz competition were as follows:


**1st Position: Syed Sibatul Hasnain Andrabi, B.Ed 4<sup>th</sup> Semester**

**2nd Position: Javid Iqbal Ganai, B.Ed 4<sup>th</sup> Semester**


**3rd Position: Muntazar Manzoor, UG 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester**


