One-Day Seminar on "Hamara Samvidhan, Hamara Swabhiman" 75th Constitutional Day Celebration

GCOE (IASE), Srinagar | July 31, 2025--- To mark the 75th Constitution Day, the Debates and Seminar Committee in collaboration with the NSS Units of the institution organized a one-day Seminar on the theme "Hamara Samvidhan, Hamara Swabhiman". The event brought together faculty, students and guest speakers in a reflective and inspiring celebration of India's Constitution. The seminar commenced with a **welcome address** by **Mr. Fazl Illahi** (Teacher Educator) who eloquently articulated how the Constitution of India serves as a mission statement for the nation. He emphasized its role in providing direction, structure and purpose to the country's democratic and pluralistic framework. This was followed by a **backdrop presentation** by **Prof. Lateef Ahmad Shah** (Assistant Professor Education) who provided a historical overview of the formation of the Constituent Assembly. He explained the mandate under which it operated and the monumental responsibility entrusted to its members to frame the document that would shape the Republic of India. The **keynote address** was delivered by **Prof. Aijaz Manzoor** (Assistant Professor of Political Science, Govt. Degree College for Women, Pulwama). Prof. Manzoor provided a profound analysis of the Constitution as a representation of India's *collective life*, elaborating on both its *foundational* and *post-foundational moments*. He traced India's transformation from a colonized land to a sovereign, democratic republic, emphasizing how the Constitution became a source of pride and identity. His address also touched upon the *governance texts* embedded in the constitutional discourse, shedding light on the balance between rights and responsibilities.


The seminar further featured **presentations by students**, which added vibrancy and youth perspectives to the event. The student presenters included:


