PROGRAMME: AN AUTOBIOGRAPHICAL WRITE UP PROGRAMME

THEME: ROLE OF CONSTITUTION IN SHAPING OUR LIVES

DATE: 14TH AUGUST 2025

To commemorate the 75th Anniversary of the Indian Constitution titled *HamaraSamvidhanHamaraSwabhiman- Our Constitution Our Pride*, a write up programme was organised by the Department of Languages in collaboration with Debates and Seminar Committee highlighting the richness of India's Linguistic Diversity and the spirit of Unity in Diversity. The theme of the Programme was "An autobiographical account with special focus on How the Constitution is Shaping Our lives". The main objective of the event was to educate the students on the significant aspects of the Constitution and its role in enabling Indian citizens to achieve their free potentials. The participants through their personal narratives promoted the understanding of the Constitution of India among its citizens. Also to reflect on the ways Constitutional values influence everyday life, the participants accentuated the importance of this living document.

A total number of 12 students from different Linguistic backgrounds shared their autobiographical sketches in their mother tongue as well as in secondary languages. Languages used were English, Urdu, Hindi and Kashmiri making the event reflection of India's Linguistic Diversity. Each narrative was a personal journey with the feelings of constitutional values such as justice, equality, fraternity, secularism and democratic rights.

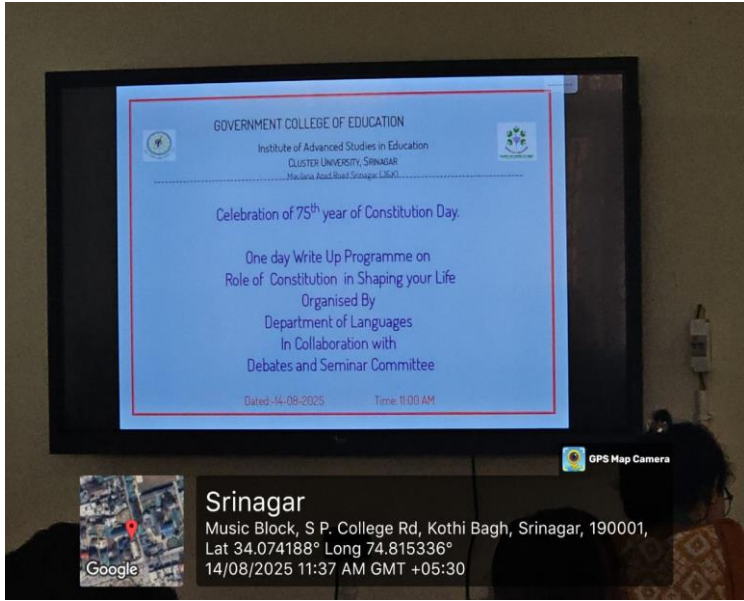


