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## REPORT

### INAUGURAL SESSION OF THE TWO DAYS NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON INTEGRATING AI AND 21<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY SKILLS IN EDUCATION

The inaugural session of the Two-Days National Conference on “**Integrating AI and 21st Century Skills in Education**” was organized by the **Innovation and Action Research Cell/IQAC** of the **Government College of Education (IASE), Cluster University Srinagar**, in collaboration with the **School Education Department, Kashmir** on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2025. The session commenced with the registration of participants at 9:30 a.m. followed by the formal inaugural proceedings at 10:00 a.m. in the college auditorium.

The session began with the felicitation of the guests and the welcome address by **Prof. (Dr.) Seema Naz, Nodal Principal, Kashmir Division Colleges and Principal, GCOE/IASE**, who warmly welcomed the dignitaries and participants. She highlighted the importance of integrating artificial intelligence and 21st-century skills in education to make learning more dynamic and future-ready. The Chief Guest, **Ms. Sakina Masood Itoo, Hon’ble Minister for Education, Health, Medical Education, and Social Welfare, UT of J&K**, delivered the inaugural address.
