REPORT ON "MICRO-TEACHING WORKSHOP (B.ED 2ND SEM BATCH 2025-IN-SERVICE)

The Micro-Teaching Workshop for Batch 2025 – in-Service (2nd Semester) commenced on 14th of October 2025. On the very first day, the opening remarks were delivered by **Prof. Seema Naz Principal of the college**. She highlighted the importance of the workshop and urged the teacher trainees to take full advantage of the opportunity, as it would help them to learn the basic teaching skills that contribute to the transformation of their behaviour and aid in becoming inspiring educators of society. The workshop was conducted in two phases:

1. Demonstration of Skills by Experts

2. Actual Practice of Skills by Teacher Trainees

In the first phase, various experts explained and demonstrated the major Micro-Teaching skills, which included:

- **General Orientation about Micro-Teaching** by Dr. Syed Riyaz Ahmad Shah Coordinator Micro-Teaching Govt. College of Education Srinagar.
- **Skill of Set Induction** by Prof. Mehraj Din Dar Dean Students Welfare Govt. College of Education Srinagar.
- **Skill of Probing Questions** by Dr. Showkeen Bilal Coordinator Teacher Education Govt. College of Education Srinagar.
- **Skill of Stimulus Variation** by Prof. Gurmeet Kour Former Dean Faculty of Arts Govt. College of Education Srinagar.
- **Skill of Reinforcement** by Prof. Altaf Shah Syed Coordinator Examination & NSS Govt. College of Education Srinagar.
- **Skill of Explanation** by Prof. Feroz Ahmad Wani Coordinator B.Ed. Distance Education Programme at Govt. College of Education Srinagar.
- **Skill of Integration** by Dr. Syed Riyaz Ahmad Shah Coordinator Micro-Teaching Govt. College of Education Srinagar.

Each expert demonstrated a skill aligned with their area of specialization. The primary objective was to familiarize teacher trainees with foundational Micro-teaching skills that are critical in developing into effective educators. Special focus was laid on "*How to Teach than What to Teach*" – covering aspects such as motivating students, framing and asking questions, applying reinforcement in learning, explaining concepts effectively, maintaining learner attention, and integrating all these skills into the actual teaching-learning process.

The second phase of the workshop began on 1st of November 2025 and focused on the practical application of the skills demonstrated earlier. All teacher trainees were divided into four groups based on their Roll numbers. Each group was assigned two mentors responsible for evaluating

and guiding the trainees in lesson preparation and the demonstration of Micro-lessons using various skills. The mentors included for Group A Prof. Mehraj Din Dar & Mr. Fazl Illahi, for group B Prof. Mohd Ishaq Dar & Prof. Nahida, for Group C Prof. Younis Basit & Prof. Nahida Naseem and for Group D Prof. Lateef Ahmad Shah & Prof. Masrat Janbaz. Every teacher trainee was required to prepare and practice a total of eight skills, including three compulsory ones —Set Induction, Stimulus variation, and Integration and one optional skill chosen from Reinforcement, Explanation, and Question Probing. Each trainee's performance was evaluated by peer reviewers and their respective supervisors. Ratings and constructive feedback were shared on the spot with each teacher trainee. Based on the feedback, student teachers were encouraged to re-plan as well as re-teach their lessons until they achieved competency in the respective skill. The workshop concluded on 18th of November 2025 with the concluding remarks delivered by Dr. Showkeen Bilal Coordinator B.Ed. M.Ed. Programmes. He felt satisfied with the achievement of the workshop and urged the teacher trainees to integrate these skills in actual teaching process that will help them to become the effective teachers of the society. The workshop concluded with the vote of thanks by the Coordinator Micro-Teaching Committee by thanking the worthy principal of the college as well as all the mentors as without their support the objective of the workshop would not have been achieved.
