## **REPORT ON THE OBSERVANCE OF "DAY OF PLEDGE AGAINST CHILD MARRIAGE"**

The Government College of Education, Institute of Advanced Studies in Education (IASE), Cluster University Srinagar, observed the Day of Pledge Against Child Marriage on 27 November 2025, as per the communication received from the Office of the District Social Welfare Officer (DSWO), Srinagar. This observance was part of a district-wide campaign initiated under instructions from the Social Welfare Department to raise awareness about the harmful effects of child marriage and to encourage public commitment towards its prevention.

The programme witnessed active participation from the Students and Faculty members of the college. The gathering reflected the institution's commitment towards social responsibility and child welfare. The event commenced at 01:30 PM in the Multipurpose Hall. Dr. Irfat Ara Khan (Dean Students Welfare) formally opened the session with a brief address explaining the purpose of the programme. Following this, all attendees collectively took the Pledge Against Child Marriage, reaffirming their commitment to prevent and report instances of child marriage in their communities. The pledge was administered in Hindi language by Ms Daljeet Kaur (APTI) and in English language by Ms Nashra (B.Ed 1st semester). The pledge emphasized rejecting all forms of child marriages, standing against practices that harm children, promoting education and awareness and Supporting legal actions aimed at stopping child marriage. The event effectively sensitized students and staff about the need to eliminate child marriage and uphold child rights. The programme concluded with a message encouraging students to act as ambassadors of social change.
