discipline, and responsible behaviour sets a powerful example that discourages drug use. Teachers can perform a pivotal role in early identification of drug addiction among children and are in a strong position to notice behavioural changes—such as sudden drop in performance, isolation, or aggression—that may signal potential drug use. Early identification allows timely guidance or referral to counsellors.



A supportive and inclusive classroom reduces stress, anxiety, and feelings of alienation—common factors that can push young people toward substance abuse. Teachers often act as informal counsellors. By listening and guiding students, they can help them deal with personal problems without resorting to harmful behaviours. Teachers act as a bridge between school and home. They can inform parents about warning signs, organize awareness programs and work with community organizations to promote anti-drug campaigns.
