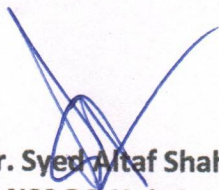

environmental conservation, community participation, and sustainable lifestyles among students and the wider community in accordance with the vision of Mission LiFE.

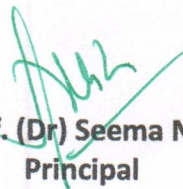

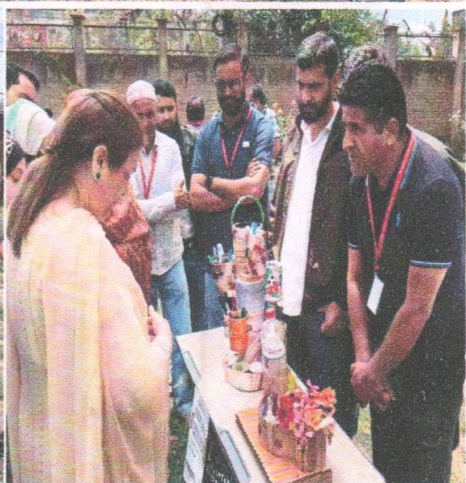
