Brief Report on One-Day College Excursion to Pahalgam

A one-day college excursion to **Pahalgam** was organised by the college on **25 August 2026** with the objective of enabling students to explore the natural phenomena and natural phenamena of the **Lidder Valley** and to facilitate experiential learning beyond the classroom.

Approximately **120 students**, accompanied by **20 escorting staff members**, participated in the excursion. The journey was undertaken in **three buses hired from JKRTC, Srinagar**. The buses followed the route plan and timings prescribed by the college, ensuring the smooth and orderly conduct of the excursion.

The picnic party departed from the college in the early morning between **7:00 and 7:30 a.m.** and reached Pahalgam at approximately **11:30 a.m.** From 11:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., the students explored the scenic landscape of the Lidder Valley and observed its prominent natural features, thereby gaining practical exposure to concepts related to physical geography, river processes, valley formation, vegetation and the overall mountain environment. Lunch was served to the students at around **1:30 p.m.**

The return journey commenced at approximately **4:30 p.m.**, and the picnic party reached the college safely between **7:00 and 7:30 p.m.** The excursion concluded smoothly and without any untoward incident.
